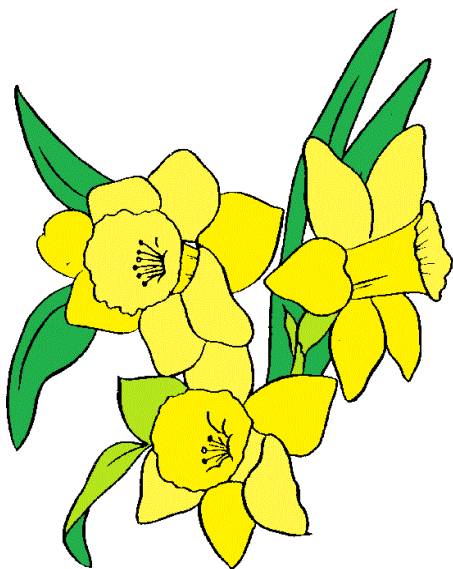

Short History of Village Green

More than 40 years ago David Williams talked with John Trevenen about organizing a team of dancers to perform in a British Folkways show at Pantages Theatre. The dancers involved enjoyed the dancing so much that they met several times over the next year. In September 1975, the Village Green English Country Dancers and the Village Green Morris Men began meeting on a weekly basis.

In the early years, under the direction of John and David, Village Green was involved in many demonstrations. They performed at the Christmas Fantasy show at the Centennial Concert Hall, The Winnipeg Folk Festival, Folklorama, Festival of Nations and the Market Square in the Exchange, to name a few. In recent years our demonstrations have included dancing at the St. Norbert's Farmers Market and First Friday's in the Exchange.

The group now has over 50 members, 5 teachers and its own house band, The Fine Companions. We hold a weekly class on Wednesday evening at Harrow United Church and a class for more experienced dancers twice a month.

His contributions were recognized by CDSS in 2015 when he was awarded ‘ The Lifetime Contribution Award’.
