A1: 1-4 $\quad$ 1st Corners Right hand turn halfway; set
5-8 Cast around $P$ back home.
A2: 1-4 2nd Corners Left hand turn halfway; set
5-8 Cast around $P$ back home.
B1: 1-4 Circle 1 x
5-8 Set \& link
B2: 1-4 Rights \& Lefts -2 changes
5-8 P 2-hand turn halfway; 1s cast; 2s lead up

## BE KIND

4 couples longways
A1: 1-4 Ends meet \& cast 1 place WHILE middles meet \& lead to nearest end. 4 waltz steps
5-8 4s in centre - Star Right.
A2: $\quad 1-4 \quad 4 \mathrm{~s}$ at ends - Star Left.
5-8 Middles meet \& cast back to home WHILE Ends meet, lead in \& face other end.

B: 1-4 $\quad 4 \mathrm{~s}$ In centre - 1 st Corners cross; 2nd Corners cross;
5-8 4s at ends - 1st Corners cross; 2nd Corners cross.
9-12 All 8 Circle halfway.
13-16 Partner Two hand turn to own side. (middles $1 x$; ends $1 / 2$ or $11 / 2$ )

A1: 1-4 1st corners Right hand turn 1x
5-6 Ps - Right shoulder siding
7-8 All turn single Left back to place
A2: 1-4 2 nd Corners Left hand turn 1 x .
5-6 Ps - Left shoulder siding
7-8 All turn single Right back to place
B: 1-4 Circle Left halfway \& fall back
5-8 Rights \& Lefts - 2 changes
9-12 1 s cross $\&$ go below ending in middle of a Line of 4 facing up
WHILE 2 s lead up \& cast onto ends of line
13-16 Line of 4 up a double \& back
17-20 1s cross trail up \& around 2s to progress WHILE 2s meet \& lead up

## BONNY KATE OF PERTH

3 Couples longways
A1: 1-4 With 2 skip changes 1 s dance down middle of set; with 4 walking steps turn away from each other to face out below 3s.
$5-8 \quad 1 \mathrm{~s} \& 3 \mathrm{~s}$ handy hand turn 1 x finishing with 1 s facing out $-(\mathrm{M}-\mathrm{RH}, \mathrm{W}-\mathrm{LH})$.
A2: 1-4 Repeat A1:with 1s dancing up outside and meeting at top of set to face out at home.
5-8 1s \& 2s handy hand turn $1 \mathrm{x}-(\mathrm{M}-\mathrm{LH}, \mathrm{W}-\mathrm{RH}) .1 \mathrm{~s}$ end facing out.
B1: 1-8 Morris hey (skip change). 1s end facing out.
B2: $\quad 1-4 \quad 1 \mathrm{~s}$ \& 2 s gypsy $-\mathrm{M}-\mathrm{L}, \mathrm{W}-\mathrm{R} .2$ s lead up to 1 st place WHILE 1 s continue down outside to 2 nd place.
5-8 1s lead down centre \& turn away from each other Into 3rd place WHILE 3s long cast up to 2nd place.
Repeat 2 x

## BRIGHT SHINING SEA

A1: 1-4 $\quad P$ Left hand turn $1 x$; keep holding hands
5-8 Balance towards P and away. Turn single over Right shoulder.
A2: 1-4 $P$ Right hand turn 1x; keep holding hands.
5-8 Balance towards $P$ and away. Turn single over Left shoulder into....
B: 1-8 Mirror hey
9-12 P Back to back
13-16 Tops lead to bottom
WHILE 2s \& 3s face up, lead up individually \& curl out to place.

## BRIMSTONE AND TREACLE

4 couples longways $1 s$ and 3 s Improper
A1: 1-4 Middles half figure 8 out through nearer end.
5-6 Middles 2 changes of Rights \& Lefts. Face N at end for...
7-8 Grand chain - 2 changes into.....
A2: 1-4 New Middles half figure 8 out through nearer end.
5-6 Middles 2 changes of Lefts \& Rights. Face N at end for...
7-8 Grand chain - 2 changes Left \& Right.
All home in P's place.
B1: 1-2 Top couple 2-hand turn halfway into
3-4 Top 2 couples circle left halfway.
5-8 Middles draw poussette halfway CCW (4 waltz steps)
B2: 1-2 Original 1s (in 3rd place) 2-hand turn halfway into
3-4 Bottom 2 couples circle left halfway.
5-7 All turn single (3 waltz steps)
$8 \quad$ All trade places with P passing Left shoulder.
Progression: 2-3-4-1
Dance: Colin Wallace.

## CHICAGO

A1: 1-4 In 4 s circle Left 1 x : end facing N .
5-8 Half hey up \& down, passing Right to start.
A2: 1-4 In 4s Star Right halfway; middles Star Left halfway and face ends.
5-8 Half hey up \& down, passing Right to start.End facing N up and down.
B1: 1-4 $\quad \mathrm{N}$ back to back.
5-8 N 2-hand turn halfway and lead out.
B2: 1-4 N 2-hand turn halfway and lead back in.
5-8 P back to back.
Progression: 2-4-1-3

## THE CORONATION DAY

Longways duple
A1: 1-4 $\quad$ 1s lead down to 2nd place, cross into P's place and face $P$ WHILE 2s wide cast up.

A2: 1-4 2 s repeat.
All home and crossed over.
B1: 1-4 Current 2nd Corners pass L; With P on the side Right shoulder round half-way.
5-8 New 2nd Corners pass L; with N on the side Right shoulder round halfway.
All progressed.
B2: 1-4 1s lead up
WHILE 2s move down the outside; all turn single away from neighbour (ones up, twos down).
5-8 1 s cross \& cast as 2 s lead up; 1 s cross to own side.

A $1 \quad$ W1 set forward to M2
WHILE M1 set forward to W2.
2-3 Corners Right hand turn 1x; 1s finish in P's place at home.
4-5 1s cross by left shoulder, go down the outside, come up between 2nd couple \& turn to face neighbour.
6-7 With N arm right 1 x , ending in a line of 4 facing down. 1 s in the middle.

B 1-2 Fall back a double (up the hall), go forward a double.
3-4 Turning towards neighbour, change line to face up.
Fall back a double (down the hall) and come forward a double.
$5 \quad$ 2s gate the 1s up and around to progressed place

## THE ELY WALTZ <br> Circle

32 bar waltzes
A1: 1-8 Circle left.
Circle right.

A2: 1-4 Right-hand turn partner (3 bars), pass P by R shoulder.
5-8 Left-hand turn the next, pass by $L$ shoulder.

B1: 1-4 Give right to number 3: balance forward \& back; box the gnat.
5-8 Balance again; do a wide Petronella turn single so men have backs to centre, ladies are on the outside facing this Partner, flowing into...

B2: 1-4 Back to back.
5-8 Waltz around, finishing back in the circle.

A1: 1-8 1 s cross over \& go below. 2s move up. 1s 2-hand turn halfway, lead down through $3 \mathrm{~s} \&$ cast back up to middle place. Stay wide.

A2: 1-8 Right file (W) star Left halfway; Left file (M) star Right halfway. Starting with 1 s trade stars, $W$ going in front of $P$. Turn stars halfway \& open up to lines with 1 s in middle. All crossed over. 2-1-3

B1: 1-4 Lines of 3 go forward \& back.
5-8 Circle 6 halfway. All on own side. 3-1-2
B2: 1-4 Top 2 couples trade places with $P$ \& go down 1 place WHILE bottom couple set \& lead up to top. 2-3-1
5-8 All swing.

## MARY K

Longways duple Improper
Cm 3/2
A1: 1-3 Men cast over right shoulder, behind neighbour to each other's place
4 With partner, 2-hand turn $1 / 2$ way
A2: 1-3 Women cast over right shoulder, behind partner to each other's place
4 With neighbour, 2 hand turn $1 / 2$ way
B 1-2 Circle four $1 / 2$ way, fall back
3-4 Face partner, pass through, turn back into set
5-6 2 changes of rights and lefts, starting with partner
7-8 With partner, 2 hand turn once round.
C Petit Fours
1-4 1s lead UP, face each other, fall back, face down, lead down outside, face each other, meet in middle
WHILE 2s face each other, fall back, face down, lead down outside, face each other, meet in middle, lead up centre
5-8 With the next couple Repeat $1-4$, 1 s lead DOWN to start

A1: 1-4 1 s clap, cross \& go below.
2s move up.
5-8 1s 2 -hand turn to own side $-1 / 2$ or $11 / 2$
A2: 1-8 2 s repeat A1. All home.
B1: 1-4 1 s cross \& go below. (No clap)
5-8 1 s half figure 8 up.
B2: 1-8 Rights \& Lefts: 4 changes.

## MR. HAMILTON'S INAUGURATION

Longways duple
G 9/8

A: 1-4 Neighbour Left hand turn 1x.
2nd Corners Hole in the Wall to trade places. (LEFT shoulder)
5-8 With P on the side Right hand turn 1 x .
1st Corners Hole in the Wall to trade places. (RIGHT shoulder)
B: 1-2 Circle halfway.
3-4 P 2-hand turn halfway; keep holding inside hands \& face Ns.
5-6 Set LEFT; turn single RIGHT into
7-8 Single file circle halfway CW to progressed places \& face new Ns.

## THE POTTER'S WHEEL

Longways duple
A 1-4 Rights and Lefts: 4 changes starting Right hand to $P$.
5-8 1s Right-hand turn $11 / 2$ to end facing W2
B 1-4 Dolphin hey for 3 across the set, starting by passing W2 by Left shoulder.
5-6 2s cast up to progressed place WHILE 1s, with M1 in lead, go down middle of set \& curve to own side.
7-8 All Right-hand turn P once round.

## SAINT MARGARET'S HILL

3 couples longways
A 1-4 1 s cast into middle place - 2s move up.1s 2-hand turn $3 / 4$ to lines of 3 across the set.
W1 between 2s; M1 between 3s.
5-8 Lines of 3 fall back, come forward into circle halfway
B1: 1-2 1 s with person on Right - Right hand turn 1 x
3-4 1s Left hand turn $3 / 4$; end facing down IMPROPER
5-8 1s lead down through bottom couple, cast back up to middle place, 2-hand turn halfway to end on own side.

B2: 1-2 1 s with person on Right, Left hand turn 1 x
3-4 1s Right hand turn $3 / 4$; end facing up IMPROPER.
5-6 1s lead up through top couple, cast to middle.
7-8 All 2-hand turn halfway.
Repeat 2 more times.

A1: 1-4 1 st corners cast around N , pass each other Left shoulder in centre, go around $P$ to end in each other's place.

A2: 1-4 2nd Corners repeat, passing Right in centre.
B1: 1-4 All fall back and come forward, pass $P$ and loop $R$ to face Partner. 5-8 Circular hey: 4 changes no hands

B2: 1-4 Current 2 nd corners change by Left; 1 st corners change Right. Quick circle 1x. All home Improper.
5-8 1s long cast and 2-hand turn half way WHILE 2s 2 -hand turn $11 / 2$ moving up to progressed place.
