David Macemon (Portland, Oregon): More years ago than he would like to admit, David was fortunate to be introduced to dancing when he was invited to help start a high school based performing group that demonstrated English Country Dance, Contra, Morris, and Sword dancing. He has been dancing and teaching ever since. David is known for his patient and clear teaching style— he communicates the joy of dancing through his teaching and his enthusiasm. He has been on staff for dance weeks and weekends around the country including Pinewoods, Buffalo Gap, Mendocino, Hey Days, and Berea Christmas Country Dance School. He is a regular caller for the weekly Portland Country Dance Community's English dance and the monthly advanced dance series. He also teaches dance—English, Contra, Morris, and Sword—at the Renaissance School of Arts and Sciences in Portland Oregon.



The Dancehall Players (Victoria, BC) have been playing together in since 2001 when Ann Schau and Dan Page first began to play regularly for the local English Country dances. They are now a five-member English Country Dance ensemble (piano, violin, flute, recorder, guitar, banjo, mandolin, cello, and percussion), and are often called upon to play for dances in Victoria, Vancouver, and the BC Gulf Islands.

Over the past 13 years, this ensemble of musicians and composers has recorded seven albums of original and traditional dance music — featuring collaborations with international dance callers. Links to their music can be found at <u>thedancehallplayers.com</u>
