**Gene Murrow** (New York) is an accomplished and long-time English Country Dance leader and musician. He's danced, taught, led workshops and balls, called at clubs, and performed at festivals throughout the US, Canada, England, Europe, and Japan. He's been involved with the iconic *Pinewoods Dance Camp* as a CDSS staff member since 1965; he's chaired a number of dance weeks over the years (Early Music, English, and English/American), and in 1996 he created what is now known as the *New London Assembly*—a week-long conference focusing on both the scholarly and practical aspects of English Country Dance as part of the *Amherst Early Music Festival*. In 2001, Gene was invited to present a paper examining the history of English Country Dance at a conference held to mark the 350<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Playford's *English Dancing Master*,

and in 2004 Gene was honoured to lead the dances for the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary gala of the Sidmouth International Festival. Gene comes to us not only as an experienced dance leader and a scholar versed in the history of English Country Dance, but also as a classically trained musician who's recorded music for the dances of Fried Herman and Gary Roodman, and who's produced a 15-disc series of ECD recordings for *Bare Necessities*. As a teacher, he's also developed a resource guide and training curriculum on musicianship for ECD teachers (courses offered at Pinewoods, Mendocino, and Berea). We look forward to welcoming Gene to Victoria.



**The Dancehall Players** (Victoria, BC) have been playing together in since 2001—when Ann Schau and Dan Page first began to play regularly for the local English Country dances. They are now a five-member English Country Dance ensemble (piano, violin, flute, recorder, guitar, banjo, mandolin, cello, and percussion), and are often called upon to play for dances in Victoria, Vancouver, and the BC Gulf Islands.

Over the past 14 years, this ensemble of musicians

and composers has recorded eight albums of original and traditional dance music — featuring collaborations with international dance callers. Links to their music can be found at <u>thedancehallplayers.com</u>
